Sacramental Preparation at St. Joseph's

Sacramental preparation involves, in an integral way, the family, the parish community, and the catechetical program. We recall that:

- 1. A sacrament involves a relationship with Jesus and therefore presumes faith on the part of the individual, the family and the community.
- 2. The readiness of the candidates and their families are essential criteria for assessing when the celebration of sacraments should take place.
- 3. The family has an essential role in preparation for the celebration of sacraments. Parents are constantly teaching and catechizing, positively or negatively, by their attitudes, actions, values; by the way they encourage prayer or not; by their active participation in worship or their lack of it.

Parents have no choice about whether to be teachers of their children. Their only choice is to be good teachers or poor teachers. Because of their significant influence, families need to be involved in the preparation for and celebration of sacraments.


